

The International Center for Water Resources and Global Change (ICWRGC) located at the Federal Institute of Hydrology in Koblenz, Germany, seeks to appoint a

Scientific officer (m / w / d), M. Sc. in Hydrology, Computer Science, Geosciences, Climatology, Meteorology (or related subject), with a related PhD degree

It is a temporary position starting in January 2020 for the period of approximately one year.

The main tasks of the position holder will involve i) scientific contributions to and management of ongoing research projects with international partners on climate change impacts on Mediterranean water resources, nature-based solutions for water supply in sub-Saharan Africa, quantification of indicators of the sustainable development goals, interactions between water, food and energy; ii) development, coordination and maintenance of international cooperation and research networks, iii) Training and education of students and international experts, including supervision of students in cooperation with universities; iv) Writing scientific publications.

The main requirements for candidates are i) experience in the implementation of scientific projects and their management; ii) in-depth knowledge and experience in the analysis of hydrological/climatological data, hydrological processes, statistics, and tools (script languages, mapping tools, etc.); iii) Very good language skills in English and iv) Very high communication and presentation skills in intercultural and international settings.
